

OZHELP FOUNDATION

The OzHelp Foundation (OzHelp) was established in 2001 after David O'Bryan, a young building apprentice from Canberra, took his own life. That same year, three others who were connected to the ACT building and construction industry died by suicide within a three-month period.

These events brought together David's mother Loraine O'Bryan with representatives from the Master Builders Association (MBA) ACT and the Construction Forestry Mining and Energy Union ACT Branch (CFMEU) who sought action to address the wellbeing and care of industry apprentices.

The MBA ACT remains as a Founding Member of OzHelp and has actively and continuously supported and promoted the objectives and purpose of OzHelp since its inception.

THE SUICIDE AWARENESS BALL

In 2018, two passionate nurses working in the Canberra Hospital Emergency Department committed to doing whatever they could to reduce the incidence of suicide and improve acute crises responses after experiencing the high prevalence of suicide and people in a mental health crises.

In 2019, the inaugural Suicide Awareness Ball was held. People from all walks of life - corporate, business, charities, medical and allied professionals, government and the public came together to make a difference.

The community's frontline responders and support networks were honoured, as were the friends and family of those who have died by suicide

After a record sell out in three minutes in 2021, the Suicide Awareness Ball had a last minute venue change to accommodate over 1,000 people who wanted to support the cause.

As OzHelp was a major beneficiary of this event, the wonderful organisers, Shannon Narracott and Britt Shephard have handed the reins to us to turn the Suicide Awareness Ball into OzHelp's major fundraising event that will not only help fund our lifesaving programs, but also raise awareness and discussion about mental health and wellbeing in our everyday lives.



These terms and conditions (T&Cs) constitute an agreement between you (the 'Sponsor') and OzHelp Foundation (OzHelp) (ABN: 559 099 118 500) in relation to sponsorship opportunities at the OzHelp 2023 Suicide Awareness Ball on Saturday 3 June, at Parliament House, Canberra ACT. By signing the Registration and Sponsorship Booking Form you acknowledge that you accept these T&Cs.

PAYMENT CONFIRMATION

Please complete the *Sponsorship Booking Form* and email to <u>communications@ozhelp.org.au</u>. Upon receipt of your booking form, you will be issued with written confirmation stating your sponsorship entitlements.

An invoice will then be prepared and sent for processing. All prices exclude GST - this will be added into your tax invoice.

A deposit of 50% of the total amount payable will be required within 14 days of receiving the invoice to secure your sponsorship booking. The outstanding balance must be received no later than 12 May 2023.

The Sponsor will not be entitled to any refund or payment of any other moneys. However, the event organisers will endeavour to provide the sponsor with a similar level of exposure to Suicide Awareness Ball participants if specific sponsorship components are modified or cancelled.

DISCLAIMER

The organisers shall not be liable for any loss caused by the cancellation of the Event where such cancellation is due to Force Majeure.
